
Porcupines, People, and the Lifesaving Work of Eldoret Animal Sanctuary

The Eldoret Animal Sanctuary, located in Eldoret City, Uasin Gishu County, is home to over 20 species of wildlife. For nearly two decades, the sanctuary has partnered with the Kenya Wildlife Service and other local and global conservation players to rescue, rehabilitate, and care for animals affected by habitat loss and human-wildlife conflict. It is the only facility of its kind in the entire North Rift region.

Over the years, the sanctuary has gained recognition as a trusted place of refuge not just for wildlife, but for local residents too, especially during snake-related emergencies. Venomous species like puff adders and cobras often find their way into homes in Baringo, Elgeyo Marakwet and Nandi counties, where forests have existed before, but now human activity is expanding rapidly, and natural habitats are shrinking.

But snakes aren't the only ones affected. Increasingly, community members have reported wildlife sightings and animal intrusions in their farms. Grey duikers, African hares, monitor lizards, aardvarks, and porcupines are among those caught in traps, injured by makeshift snares, or wandering in search of food and water.

In July, a dedicated team of five individuals drawn from the Eldoret Animal Sanctuary and the Brigadier Boinett Foundation enjoyed a three-day conservation education training at the Lewa Conservation Education Centre. As part of our career progression and skill development efforts, the visit provided an immersive learning experience on community-led conservation, wildlife monitoring, environmental education, and sanctuary management best practices.

The team had the opportunity to engage with Lewa's conservation educators, tour wildlife corridors, observe rhino and elephant tracking operations, and learn how conservation initiatives are integrated with local community development. The exchange also highlighted how education, tourism, and sustainable land use can work hand in hand to protect endangered species.

The visit not only deepened our team's understanding of ecosystem-based conservation approaches but also strengthened our resolve to replicate some of these models within the Eldoret Animal Sanctuary and across BBF's wider programs. We return inspired, informed, and more committed than ever to expanding our impact across the North Rift region.
